## Procedures for Summer School Scheduling effective 2014

Summer will consist of six academic terms:

- Three four-week terms that run sequentially, M-Th (and F Memorial Day week)
- Currently three terms of various lengths
- One twelve week term concurrent with all three terms
- Currently eight week term concurrent with second and third terms
- Two terms scheduled by the College of Education for cohort student classes
- Not currently on a regular schedule


## Comparison of Schedules Using Summer 2013

## Current

- Maymester M-F starts Monday, $6^{\text {th }}$ May to $24^{\text {th }}$ May (15 class days)
- Summer I M-Th starts Wednesday, 29 $^{\text {th }}$ May-27 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ June (18 class days)
- Summer II M-Th starts Monday, $1^{\text {st }}$ July-29 ${ }^{\text {th }}$ July ( 16 class days; includes $4^{\text {th }}$ of July)


## Proposed

- May M-Th starts Monday, $6^{\text {th }}$ May to $31^{\text {st }}$ May (16 class days; includes Memorial Day; includes Friday of Memorial Day week to have 16 days and keep class times constant all summer)
- June M-Th starts Monday, $3^{\text {rd }}$ June to $27^{\text {th }}$ June ( 16 class days)
- July M-Th starts Monday, $1^{\text {st }}$ July to $29^{\text {th }}$ July (16 days; includes $4^{\text {th }}$ of July)
