

## Center for Teaching and Learning at Georgia College

The Center for Teaching and Learning (CTL) at Georgia College will focus on faculty success by creating a single entity that encompasses faculty development, and instructional design and support. It will address the rapidly evolving role of technology in teaching and learning. CTL will coordinate existing and new initiatives, replacing multiple structures to improve efficiency and effectiveness. It will also interact closely with the University Library and IT. When fully developed CTL will be a one-stop shop that will advance faculty success.

CTL is a reorganization of existing resources, based on recommendations in the May 2016 report from Goldstein & Associates: Review of Academic Technology Support. CTL will rearrange existing resources; no new personnel are required for implement. CTL does not require any new physical spaces and will utilize the budgets from the units that are being reorganized. This reorganization has been reviewed and approved by the President’s Cabinet.
