Re: Election of University Senators

The 2020-2021 elections for Faculty Senators from the College of Arts and Sciences will be managed according to the college policy. All departments in the college will elect the necessary senators to replace those whose terms will end spring 2020 in accordance with their department policies. The dean's office has asked the departments to conduct and finalize elections so that we can provide the results to the Executive Committee no later than February 1, 2020.

Apportionment in the college is based on the number of department faculty as follows. Each department is allocated one senator; an additional senator is allocated to larger departments in order of number of faculty until the total matches the senate apportionment for the academic year.
