## Presiding Officer Elect Fowler,

Thank you for the information on the Senate elections. In response to the November 22nd deadline, I am providing the following information.

The COE is apportioned four Senators. We have two from the Teacher Education Department and two from the Professional Learning and Innovation Department. Dr. Rob Sumowski (2023) and Dr. Linda Bradley (2023) will remain on the Senate for the 2021-2022 academic year. Dr. Paulette Cross and Dr. Lyndall Muschell have terms ending this academic year. Therefore, we will elect two senators from the corps of instruction, who have at least two years of university service, to a three-year term. We will hold an election at our January 15, 2021 college meeting to nominate and vote for the two senators (one from each department).
