Subject: Call for At-large Elected Faculty Senator Nominations

February 13, 2023

Dear Members of the Georgia College Faculty,

The GC University Senate is seeking one faculty member to serve as an at-large elected faculty senator for a three-year term (2023-2024, 2024-2025, 2025-2026) commencing April 21, 2023.

At-large Elected Faculty Senator Procedures: Membership of the University Senate includes three elected faculty senator positions designated as at-large elected faculty senator positions representing the entire membership of the Corps of Instruction. Each position is for a three-year term with service staggered such that an election for one at-large senator position is required each year. Eligibility for elected faculty senators from University Senate Bylaws and the Board of Regents Policy Manual is detailed below. This year's election will identify an individual to serve as the at-large elected faculty senator for a three-year term commencing April 21, 2023.

UNIVERSITY SENATE BYLAWS: II. Section 1.A.2. Elected Faculty Senators.

The eligibility requirements for elected faculty senators are membership in the Corps of Instruction as detailed in II. Section 2.A.1 and the completion of at least two (2) years of service at the university at the beginning of the fall semester following their election as an elected faculty senator.

BOARD OF REGENTS POLICY MANUAL: 3.2 Faculties, 3.2.1.1 Corps of Instruction

Full-time professors, associate professors, assistant professors, instructors, lecturers, senior lecturers, principal lecturers, and teaching personnel with such other titles as may be approved by the Board, shall be the Corps of Instruction. Full-time research and extension personnel and duly certified librarians will be included in the Corps of Instruction based on comparable training. Persons holding part-time and adjunct appointments or other honorary titles shall not be considered to be members of the faculty.

Election Procedures: The election will be coordinated by the Chair of the Subcommittee on Nominations (SCoN).

1. Call for nominations: Send nominations to robert.sumowski@gcsu.edu

Nominations open on February 13, 2023, at 8 a.m.

Nominations close on February 17, 2023, at 5 p.m.

2. Confirmation of nominations

Eligibility to serve as an elected faculty senator is confirmed by SCoN (as indicated above).

Nominated faculty must accept their nomination to be placed on the ballot.

3. Voting

Eligibility to vote is determined by the Corps of Instruction list, which informs the most recent apportionment of elected faculty senators to academic units.

Voting method: authenticated electronic vote – secret ballot

Voting opens on February 20, 2023, at 8 a.m.

Voting ends on February 24, 2023, at 5 p.m.

4. Results

The candidate receiving the most votes will be declared the At-Large Elected Faculty Senator.

In the event of a tie, the winner will be selected through a blind draw.

Election Results will be announced to the University Community no later than March 1, 2023.
