therefore be it resolved by the University Senate of Georgia College & State University that the University President identify an appropriate university official to maintain a registry of university-wide committees or a master list of committees that

- (1) provides appropriate information, including but not limited to membership rosters, committee charge, and committee meeting minutes
- (2) is accessible to members of the university community, and
- is periodically reviewed to determine the activity status of each committee
