1) Resolution on advocacy and collaboration

- a. Anticipated issues requiring collaboration
 - i. Call joint meetings with appropriate committees
 - ii. Wellness Center and Resource shifting – SAPC
 - iii. Enrollment Management – APC
 - iv. Creation of joint subcommittees
 - v. Chair collaboration over meetings outside the committee (lunch, coffee, etc.)
- b. Advocacy
 - i. Forums
 - ii. How to communicate and get feedback
 - iii. Emphasizing individual relations with departments & constituents
 - iv. Attending staff/departmental/divisional meetings
 - v. Reminders that meetings are open to entire campus community
 - vi. Critical dates calendar
 - vii. Work with committees who are addressing controversial topics to allow other committees' members to attend and learn/voice opinion
 - 1. When discussing controversial subjects the committee could hold meeting at another time than the standard committee time
 - viii. Solicit problems from the university
